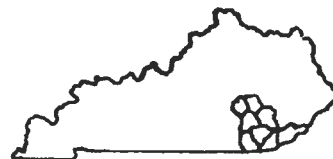

**CALL TO ORDER**

Mr. John Ed Pennington called the Regional Transportation Committee meeting to order at 10:30 a.m.

Mr. John Ed Pennington welcomed everyone to the meeting and made guest introductions. Mr. Pennington also reminded everyone that Christmas dinner would be served directly after the meeting.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Mr. Homer Lee Jackson made a motion for approval of the minutes from the August 17, 2011 RTC meeting and Mr. Mike Buckles seconded the motion. Motion carried.

**TRANSPORTATION UPDATES**

Ms. Gill informed the committee that the listing of projects by county that were handed out are the projects that have been identified by District 11 from the Transportation Improvement Plan which are being called GAP projects. The projects have been identified on a data based need and are currently not on our UPL. Ms. Gill asked the committee for a motion to accept these projects to be included on our UPL. Judge Joe Asher made a motion to accept the listing of projects and Mr. Homer Lee Jackson seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Ms. Gill reminded the committee that the Kentuckians for Better Transportation Conference is coming up on January 19th and 20th at the Hyatt Regency in Lexington, Kentucky. Ms. Gill informed the committee that an email would be sent regarding more information.

Ms. Gill distributed a spreadsheet listing of Park and Ride Lots that has been identified within the region. Ms. Gill asked the committee to review the listing

and provide any additional lots that they may be aware of. In addition, Ms. Gill informed the committee that this listing includes official and unofficial lots and consistent updating would be helpful to the Division of Planning to identify existing official lots in order to inform the public but to also identify any unofficial lots which would help to identify needs within that area.

Ms. Gill also informed the committee that a Bike/Pedestrian/Greenway contact list was recently due and thus far has had no luck in finding any contact information for this work element. Ms. Gill asked the committee to let her know if they were aware of any contact information that may be relative to this. Mr. Cochran with the City of London announced that the London/Laurel Connectivity Plan intends to include these types of projects and they are currently asking for additional funding to get this project underway. Mr. Cochran also mentioned the Redbud Ride which begins in Laurel County every year noting that Mr. Chris Robison with Downtown London would be the contact person.

#### **DISTRICT HIGHWAY REPORT/HIGHWAY PROJECT UPDATES**

Ms. Gill informed the committee that Mr. Joseph Mosley was unable to attend the meeting however he provided her with an update for the committee as follows:

- The first public meeting for US25 from KY1006 to KY229 in London has been conducted.
- The first Citizen's Advisory Meeting was yesterday which includes US25 from KY1006 to US25 in Corbin.
- The KY1074 Dressing Bridge in Harlan County has been let.
- The KY30, section 4, letting has been postponed until after the session.

Ms. Gill also relayed to the committee that she would keep them informed on upcoming public meetings.
